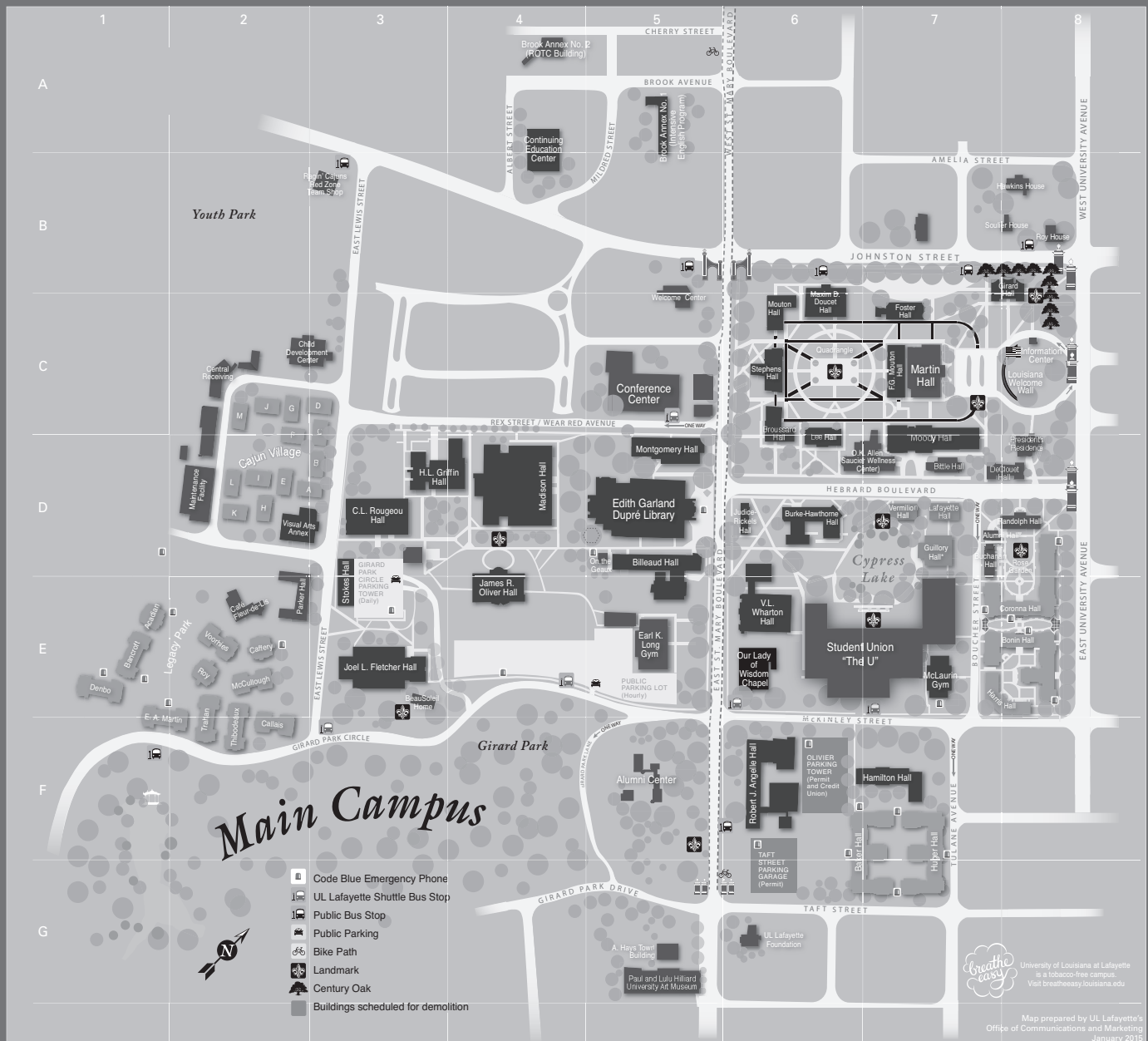

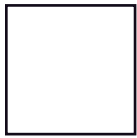

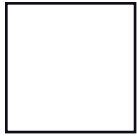
Honors Student Orientation

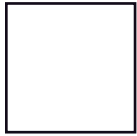
Campus involvement is critically important to your success as a student. Come learn about the many ways to be involved through our 180+ student organizations or through one of our 26 sororities and fraternities.

Pelican Room, Union rm. 207

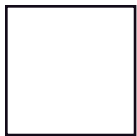
