Registering for Orientation

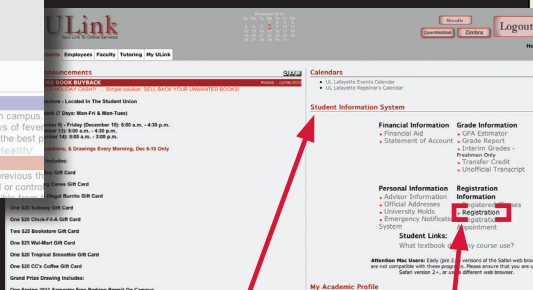
- Go to <http://portal.louisiana.edu> and log-in utilizing your username and password (sent via e-mail).
- Click on the tab marked STUDENTS.
- Under STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM, click on the link marked REGISTRATION.
- Choose TRANSFER ORIENTATION.
- Follow the prompts to register for NURS 353 – RN to BSN Student Orientation
- Once you have registered for Student Orientation you will be cleared to register for additional courses.

Online Pre-registration Instructions

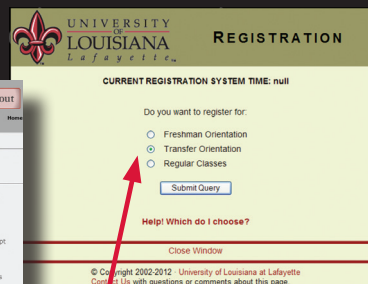
Go to <http://portal.louisiana.edu> and login using the username and password provided on your Orientation welcome letter [passwords are case sensitive].
