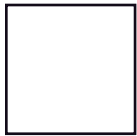
Honors Orientation Meeting

Students eligible for the Honors Program are required to attend this session to become a part of the Honors Program.



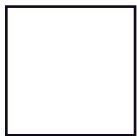
Parking and Transit

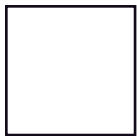
UL Lafayette Academic Scholarship recipient's session

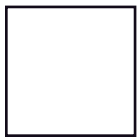
Living on Campus

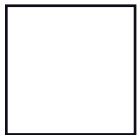
The Student Perspective

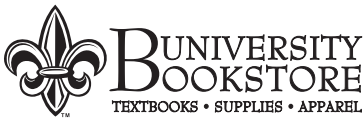
