## **New Student Convocation**

**New Student Convocation** is the official academic welcome for first-year students and marks their entrance to UL Lafayette. At Convocation, students, administrators, and faculty will share their own experiences and advice about making the most of your time at UL Lafayette, finding your people, and making your mark. Convocation will be held at the Cajundome, with doors opening at **9:00 AM** and FREE grab-and-geaux food and drinks will be available for students. Students are to wear their red Orientation t-shirt. Convocation begins at 9:30 AM. Transportation from main campus to the Cajundome will be provided in front of the Student Union. Student parking is also available at Cajun Field. **There is a clear bag policy in place at the Cajundome, please plan accordingly**.
