




Keys

EVERY RESIDENT IS GIVEN A KEY AT CHECK-IN, AND THEY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING POSSESSION OF THE KEY UNTIL CHECK-OUT.

- There is a fee for a staff member to unlock the door (each door, each time)
 - \$25 fee from 8:00 a.m. 10:00 p.m.
 - \$50 fee from 10:00 p.m. 8:00 a.m.
- The lost key fee is \$200.00. This covers replacing the key and all locks associated with the lost key. Please notify your Property Manager or RA immediately if you lose your key.

BEFORE ARRIVING, BEGIN DISCUSSIONS ABOUT THE YEAR:


- Talk sleeping and studying habits, guest expectations, and communication guidelines


