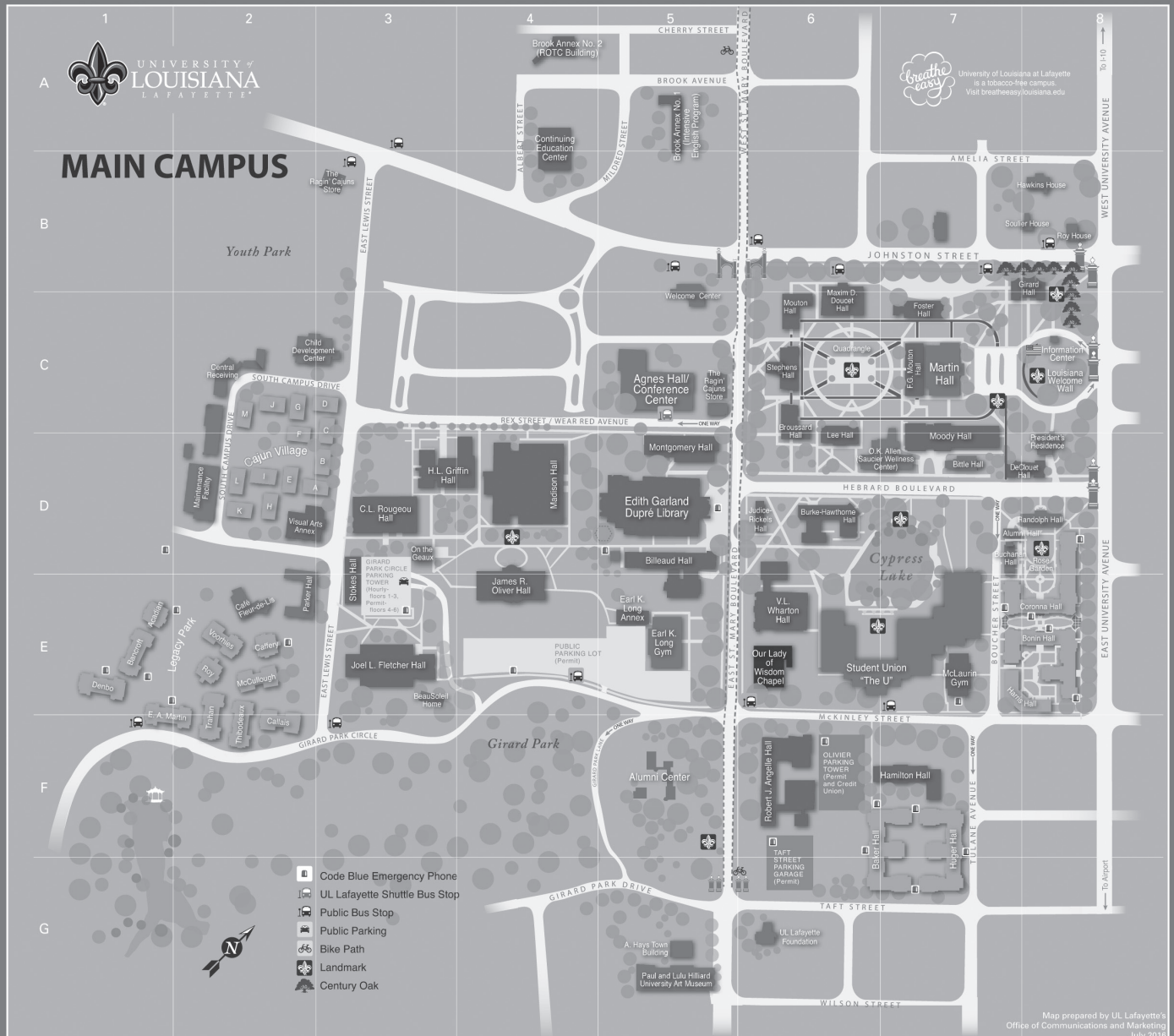

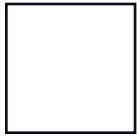

Freshman Math Placement Exam

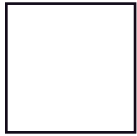

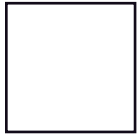
- 8:30 AM – 9:10 AM** **Optional Campus Tour**

**Money Matters*****Bayou Bijou, Union rm. 130***

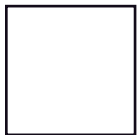

**Campus Involvement: Student Organizations & Greek Life** ***The Forum, Union rm. 209***

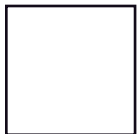
Campus involvement is critically important to your success as a student. Come learn about the many ways to be involved through our 180+ student organizations or through one of our sororities and fraternities.

**Safety and Security & Parking and Transit** ***Pelican Room, Union rm. 207***

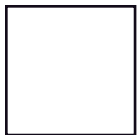

**Career Planning for Success** ***Shadows Room, Union rm. 212***

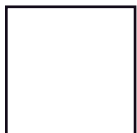
