Restriction(s): Students will be allowed to enroll in this course only three times.

Course Notes: Only one course of BIOL 110, BIOL 121, or BIOL 206 can be used towards a degree. Courses from the sequence BIOL110, BIOL 111, BIOL 112, BIOL 113 cannot be mixed-matched with courses from the non-major sequence BIOL 121, BIOL 122, BIOL 123, BIOL 124.

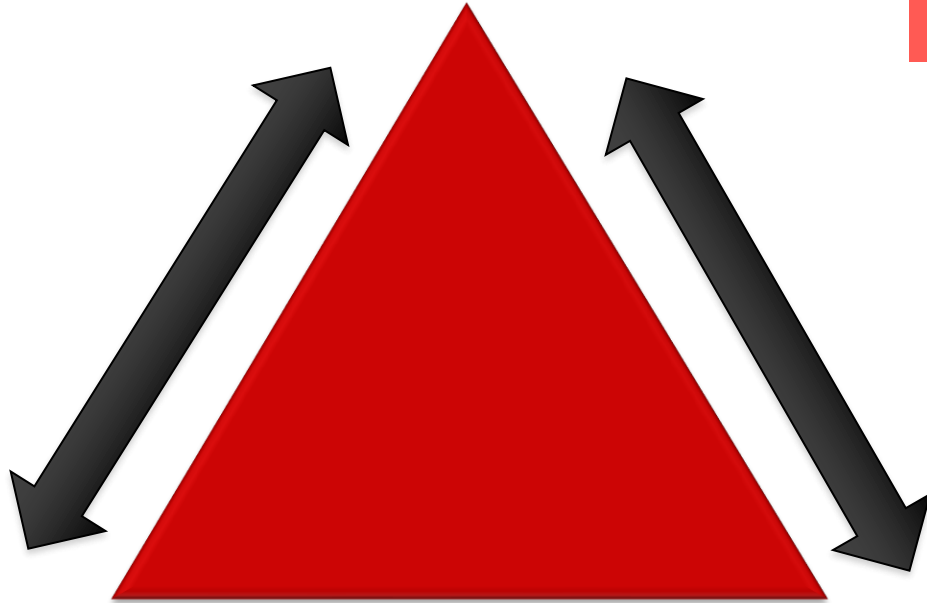
